



Geography for Non-Specialist Secondary Teachers (Webinar)

This two-part virtual course supports secondary teachers who are new to teaching geography or who are working outside their specialism.

Delegates will:

- improve their confidence in teaching geography
- develop their subject knowledge in human and physical geography
- learn how to teach disciplinary and substantive knowledge and skills
- become familiar with how geography progresses across primary and secondary education
- explore strategies to prepare students for GCSE.

This training will:

- equip teachers with the knowledge and skills required to effectively deliver high-quality lessons
- focus on Key Stage 3 teaching principally, whilst offering the requisite level of skill and knowledge to facilitate further development towards the teaching of Key Stage 4 over time
- support teachers in transition by supporting them in understanding how geography progresses from Early Years Foundation Stage – Key Stage 5
- help teachers understand what is meant by geographical concepts and how to help students develop their disciplinary knowledge and skills through geographical enquiry
- explore strategies to support students in retaining and recalling key case study knowledge to support them in GCSE examinations.
